

The journal *Ephemeris Napocensis* recognizes the increasing availability of Generative Artificial Intelligence (GenAI) tools and their potential role in supporting academic writing. To maintain the integrity, authenticity, and methodological rigor of archaeological research, the journal allows only minimal and transparent use of such tools under the following conditions:

### **Permitted Uses of GenAI**

Authors may use GenAI tools **exclusively for editorial and language-related purposes**, including:

- **Language refinement:** grammar correction, clarity improvement, and stylistic polishing.
- **Minor formatting assistance:** checking consistency in structure, references, or headings.
- **Technical editing:** improving readability without altering meaning or contributing intellectual content.

All uses must remain fully under the authors' control and supervision.

### **Prohibited Uses of GenAI**

To preserve the scholarly standards of archaeology, GenAI **must not** be used for:

- Designing, modifying, or interpreting **archaeological methodologies**, analyses, or results.
- Formulating or revising **archaeological arguments**, theoretical frameworks, or conclusions.
- Generating, altering, or identifying **archaeological data**, artefact descriptions, stratigraphic information, images, maps, or site interpretations.
- Conducting **literature searches**, extracting sources, generating citations, or producing bibliographies (due to verified risks of fabricated or inaccurate references).
- Drafting or rewriting substantial sections of the manuscript that contribute to its original scholarly content.

Under no circumstances may GenAI tools function as co-authors.

### **Transparency Requirement**

If GenAI is used for the permitted purposes outlined above, authors must include a statement in the Acknowledgements section:

“The authors used generative AI tools (e.g., ChatGPT) solely for language and editorial refinement. All research design, data analysis, interpretations, and conclusions are entirely the work of the authors.”

Any use beyond these limits must be disclosed and may lead to rejection without review.

### **Author Accountability**

Authors bear full responsibility for:

- The accuracy and authenticity of all submitted content
- The originality of the scholarly contribution
- Ensuring that GenAI use is limited, transparent, and ethical
- Complying with the journal’s editorial policies and the broader standards of archaeological research

Non-compliance with this policy may lead to manuscript rejection, withdrawal, or further editorial action.
